PRIZES/CATEGORIES

Mil-Pra AECG Award

This \$1,000 award is open to artists whose work celebrates the history and spirit of the Mil-Pra AECG Exhibition.

It is sponsored by Casula Powerhouse Arts Centre and the Mil-Pra AECG.

The winning artwork is selected by the Mil-Pra AECG committee.

Bruce & Carol Kendall OAM Memorial Award

This \$500 award is open to all artists. It acknowledges and celebrates Bruce and Carol Kendall's contribution to the Mil-Pra AECG

Maria Lock Acquisitive Award

This award is open to all artists. It is in recognition of Maria Lock, the first Aboriginal woman to be granted land. The winning artwork is acquired for the Liverpool City Art, Heritage and Local Studies Collection. The maximum acquisition amount is \$2,000.

Mayor's Choice Acquisitive Award

This award is open to all artists. The winning artwork is selected by the Mayor of Liverpool City Council for the Liverpool City Art, Heritage and Local Studies Collection. The maximum acquisition amount is \$3,000.

KARI Award

Sponsored by KARI Aboriginal Resources Inc., this \$400 1st prize and \$200 2nd prize is open to all artists.

Kate Nickolas Liverpool Women's Services Award

This \$500 award is open to female artists only and is sponsored by Liverpool Women's Resource Centre, Liverpool Women's Health Centre and South West Women's Housing.

ELIGIBILITY

The Adult Mil-Pra AECG Aboriginal Exhibition is only open to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists living in NSW or the ACT that are 18 years and over at the date of the exhibition opening. The student awards are open to any students of the appropriate age.

KEY DATES

Closing date for registration forms **Friday 12 August, 2016 (by 4.30pm)**
Entries received after this date are ineligible.

Delivery of artworks **Saturday 3 and Sunday 4 September, 2016 (10.30am – 4.30pm)**
Artworks received after 4:30pm on 4 September will not be included in the exhibition.

Collection of artworks **Sunday 23 or Sunday 30 October, 2016 (10.30am – 4.30pm)**
Any artwork not collected by Sunday 30 October 2016 may be disposed of at the discretion of CPAC.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Artists may submit up to three artworks that must not exceed 150cm by 150cm (and 100cm for 3D works). Any medium accepted. All artworks must be ready for display at time of

delivery. The artwork must be the original work of the artist and must be signed by the artist. Artworks must have been produced in the last five years and be the property of the artist or their agent. Artworks by groups of eligible artists may be entered. Please read the full Terms and Conditions on the reverse side.

HOW TO ENTER

1. Complete the Registration Form
2. Provide high resolution digital images of your artwork (at least 300dpi). Either post a CD of images with the Registration Form or email images to registration@casulapowerhouse.com Please label files with artist name and artwork title.
3. If applying for the Mayor's Choice or Maria Lock Acquisitive Awards please also attach an artist statement (max 100 words)

ARTWORK LABELS

Unlabelled artworks will not be accepted.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. All participating adult artists must be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent. All adult artists must be 18 years of age or older at the date of the exhibition. Proof of age may be required.

2. All judges will be appointed by the Mil-Pra AECG in consultation with the Casula Powerhouse Arts Centre (CPAC). Artists who have entered artworks or whose children have entered artworks are ineligible to judge any of the awards. The decision of the judge/s will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

3. All exhibiting artists will permit their artworks to be reproduced in print and electronic media for the purpose of advertising and promoting the exhibition. CPAC reserves the right to reproduce artworks in subsequent promotional material in consultation with the artist.

4. Artists are responsible for organising all transport matters including costs of the delivery and collection of their artworks.

5. All artworks must be ready for display with D-rings attached to the back of the work. CPAC will not accept any artworks that do not have D-rings attached or are wet, incomplete, structurally unstable or damaged in any way. CPAC will not

repair any artworks on the artist's behalf and will not hang them.

6. All artworks will be available for collection unwrapped. Any artists wanting to wrap their works will need to bring all wrapping or packaging with them and wrap the artworks themselves on allocated dates for collection of artwork.

7. CPAC reserves the right to refuse and/or withhold any artwork from display at its own discretion.

8. All artworks available for sale for \$100 or more will be subject to 20% commission. 10% payable to Casula Powerhouse Arts Centre and 10% payable to Mil-Pra AECG.

9. All artworks available for sale for \$99 or less will not be subject to any commission.

10. CPAC will ensure the artwork(s) are insured in the interests of all parties against loss or damage from the time the artworks are received at CPAC until the time the artwork(s) are collected by the entrant. CPAC will not be held liable for any loss or damage that occurs whilst the works are in transit. An insurance value must be declared for each entered artwork on the Registration Form. Works without an insurance value will not be accepted. A nominated insurance value is based on fair replacement cost.
