- Accommodation:** Youthworks Outdoors Rathane and Telford Conference Centre

- Accommodation Facilities:** Accommodation is bunks with linen provided. Students will need to bring their own towel. Rathane is listed by the National Trust and retains the historic charm of the original building, whilst including all modern conveniences to make your stay comfortable. Enjoying an unparalleled aspect looking straight down the Port Hacking River with plenty of wide open space.
Telford was originally the holiday homestead of the NSW Governor and is a venue full of history offering comfortable accommodation with expansive lawns stretching all the way to the edge of the river.

- Supervision:** Accompanying teachers will be responsible for the supervision of their students. All schools MUST send a supervising teacher(s)
- Times and Camp Activities:** The STEM Camp will commence at 9.00am on Tuesday 27th June 2017 and finish on Friday 29th June 2017 at approximately 2pm.
Wednesday the 28th June students will be transported off site for an all day excursion. The first stop will be the Environmental Education Centre within the Royal National Park. The second stop will be the Powerhouse Museum at Ultimo. Risk assessments will be supplied prior to the camp.
On the two other days students will attend STEM workshops on site.
A full Agenda will also be forwarded prior to the camp.
