(NSW AECG) is seeking expressions of interest for a Pirru Thangkuray Program Manager (*noting this is a hybrid work position*) to join the Pirru Thangkuray team, with the aim to meet the Premiers Priority: to *Increase the proportion of Aboriginal students attaining year 12 by 50% by 2023, while maintaining their cultural identity.*

Type of Employment: Full time – 35 hours per week
Annual Salary: \$100,100.00 per annum (inclusive of superannuation)

Position Criteria

- Aboriginality
- Hold a current & valid Working with Children's Check (WWCC) for paid employment or willingness to obtain one.
- Current NSW Driver's License
- Demonstrated and proven verbal and written Communication skills
- Proven ability to work independently to deliver to strict reporting deadlines
- Ability to collect and input data sets or willingness to learn
- Demonstrated and proven leadership and managerial skills to support a small team
- Ability to engage and work with a variety of key stakeholders
- Understanding of Aboriginal Education and working with secondary students and Aboriginal community members
- The skills to co-ordinate, facilitate and deliver Cultural Education Engagement programs
- Understanding of delivering goal setting and other support programs as required

The successful applicant will manage a small team and work across a targeted number of schools and communities across NSW and be required to undertake pre-employment screening for this role which includes a Working with Children Check and National Criminal History Check.
