Position: Mentor - Ngaarr Dhuwi Girls Academy

Ngaarr Dhuwi Girls Academy Program is a holistic program that supports our young Aboriginal women through their 7-12 educational journey. Our mentor's role is to support female Aboriginal students through culture, wellbeing and education to increase self-determination and engagement to complete school. Mentor positions are based in select schools.

Position Description

Mentors will be based in schools at a 2 mentor to 50 female Aboriginal Student Ratio full time 5 days per week. Ngaarr Dhuwi have their own cultural academy rooms which are a meeting place for our young women to feel safe and connected. Mentors will work collaboratively to establish localised programs and support catering for the needs of their female students.

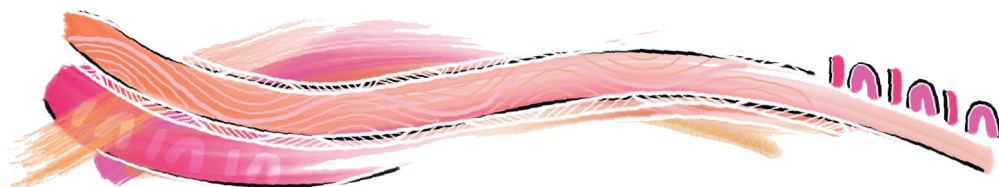
Location: Newcastle, Lake Macquarie Region

- Proven ability to facilitate and deliver cultural engagement programs
- Knowledge of the Aboriginal community in which Ngaarr Dhuwi Girls Academy operates
- Experience in working across a diverse range of Aboriginal and non- Aboriginal community groups and organisations.
- Proven and demonstrated abilities to work within a small team and individually.
- High level Information Technology, oral and written communication skills.
- Demonstrated negotiation, liaison, and interpersonal skills.
- Full COVID vaccinations
- Full NSW Drivers License
- A valid and current Working with Children Check and willingness to attain a National Probity Police Check



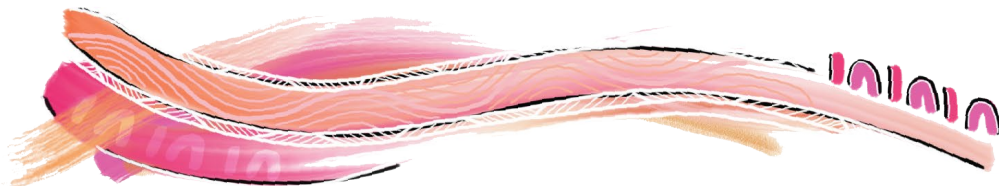
